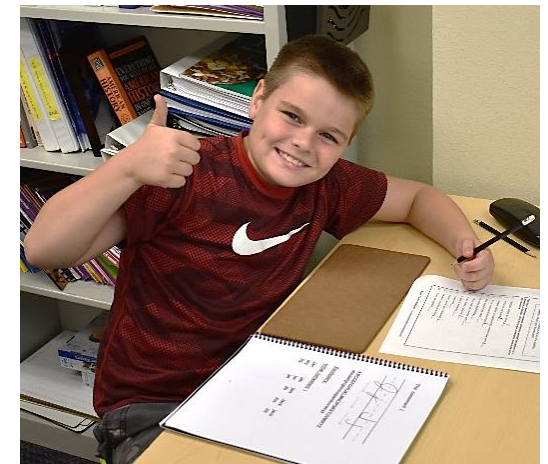

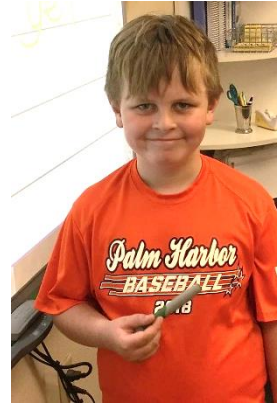
## The dePaul School for Dyslexia

The dePaul School Summer Reading Camp focuses on improving basic reading and literacy skills. Each student receives instruction in the dePaul Structured Linguistics (DPSL), Auditory Discrimination and Reading.



- **Individualized instruction for school-aged students**
- **Linguistics taught with 1:1 or 2:1 Student/Tutor ratio**
- **Emphasis placed on areas needing improvement**
- **Open to students attending other schools and dePaul students**

Classes are highly structured, sequential, teacher directed and paced to maintain the interest and attention of the student. Instructions are intensive, structured and multi-sensory. All tutors have been trained by qualified personnel in the use of dePaul materials and method.



- DPSL works to improve foundation skills in phonics, vocabulary development, grammar, and handwriting through a structured, multi-sensory curriculum.
- Reading classes are held daily.
- Direct, explicit instruction in syllabication, fluency, and reading comprehension.
- Auditory Discrimination class focuses on developing basic auditory processing skills and remediating deficiencies.



**We are currently enrolling students for our 2018 Summer Reading Camp.**

The program is designed for students struggling with reading and/or experiencing learning difficulties.

Placement screening is administered prior to program start. Dates for placement testing will be announced.

To be considered for placement in the Summer Reading Camp, please return a completed registration form with a \$500 deposit to The dePaul School by May 1, 2019.

Student registration is processed on a first come basis. The program may be filled prior to May 1, 2019. Once the program is full no additional students will be accepted.

Tuition is \$2,500 and the balance of \$2,000 is due on or before Friday, May 24, 2019.
